The mobile breast screening unit at Corbett Hospital experienced a technical fault at 9.30am today, Friday 18th March.

Women whose scans had to be cancelled as a result were offered an alternative same day examination at Russells Hall Hospital or the opportunity to re-book an appointment at Corbett Hospital once the scanner is in full working order.

The service engineers for this equipment inform us that it is unlikely to be operational again before Tuesday morning at the earliest.
