Headline	Cancer patients wait months for treatment
First paragraph/s of article	Hundreds of patients are waiting more than two months for cancer treatment at hospitals in the West Midlands, new figures reveal.
Paragraphs relating to Dudley Group	Only Dudley's Russells Hall Hospital met the Government's target of 85 per cent of admitted patients waiting a maximum of 62 days from January to March this year.
	Dudley's Russells Hall Hospital met the target with 87.5 per cent, but Sandwell and West Birmingham NHS Trust - which runs Sandwell and City Hospitals - narrowly missed it with 84.1 per cent.
