Thank you for requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

- 1. Did the hospital trust use high dose PPI medication, e.g. omeprazole, to treat Eosinophilic Oesophagitis (EoE) in children before June 2018? **No**
- 2. When did the use of high dose PPI become routine treatment for EoE? Any patients with suspected EoE are referred to tertiary centre at Birmingham for endoscopy and subsequent management
- 3. Please can you state if the Trust typically informs individual clinics regarding FOI requests made by the public. If this is not routine, please indicate circumstances when a clinician would be informed regarding a FOI request.

No, clinicians do not see all FOI requests. It would depend on what information the request is asking for as to whether a Clinician would be copied into the request or not.
