I should like to request the following information under the Freedom of Information Act. My request concerns continuous renal replacement therapy modalities in the intensive care/critical care areas of the hospitals within your Trust.

1.How many machines do you have for continual renal replacement (CRRT) in the intensive care unit/critical care unit **Two**

1a.Can you split these by manufacturer and age of machine please Manufacturer Gambro, both purchasedMay 2010

2. Are you in a contract for your machines, if so when does the contract expire **Yes, contract expires April 2017**

3. How many CRRT treatments were carried out in 2014 (or the latest 12 month period you have data for)
There were 41 CVVHDF patients and 4 CVVH patients on ITU during the financial year 14/5

4. How many bags of fluid did you use for CRRT in 2014 (or the latest 12 month period you have data for) **2126**

5. Who is your current manufacturer of fluids for CRRT **Baxter Healthcare**

6. Are you in a contract for fluids, if so, when does this expire and is it linked in with the machine contract The Trust purchase fluids from a Framework Agreement negotiated by Health Trust Europe. The framework ends on 3/1/16. The purchase of fluids is not linked to the purchase of a machine/s.

7.What was your total spend on CRRT fluids in 2014 (or the latest 12 month period you have data for)
