I would be grateful if you could supply undergraduate timetables issued to students in years 3 - 5 of the Medicine A100 course for the academic year 2014/2015 for students placed at The Dudley Group of Hospitals NHS Trust from Birmingham medical school. (Medicine A100 refers to the standard medicine course and does not include graduate entry medical students).

Please find attached the responses to your request.

3rd year students come here in two separate semesters and are divided into Firms. We have 10 Firms per Semester. There can be anywhere from 4 – 6 students in a Firm

Enclosed are 3rd Year Programmes for Firms 1 – 10 for Semester one and again for Semester 2.

Please note:

4th year Rotations are defined as follows:

P1R1 = Phase 1, Rotation 1

P1R2 = Phase 1, Rotation 2

SPC is Surgery and Perioperative Care

SPMA is Specialty Medicine A

SPMA is Specialty Medicine B

4th Years have individual timetables. The 4th years come for 18 week phases twice a year. Each phase is divided into a rotation of 9 weeks. (I have only sent over one phase as Phase 2 would be a mirror image more or less of Phase 1, but with different students.

For 5th year students please find attached a copy of the overview of where the students are placed for both 5th year rotations and also the teaching programmes for both rotations.

5th Years – 2 x 15 week blocks for the Acutely Ill Patient.

All students follow the teaching programmes sent. They are based in the specialties given in the structure sent when they are not following the teaching programme
