 - 2) The amount spent on all costs by The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust for the years of 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.
 - 3) The company The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust buy their condoms from.
 - 4) How much money does The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust pay per one condom from their suppliers.
 - 5) The amount of money that The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust has spent on other forms of contraception in the years of 2011,2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.
 - 6) Where the suppliers company based (country and city) were The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust buy their condoms from.
- The Sexual Health service is currently up for tender and The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust is one of the providers bidding for the service, therefore, the Trust would like to use FOI exemption Section 43 Commercial Interest for the information asked for in questions 1 – 6.

 - 8) How many different people received free condoms from the NHS in the years of 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.
 - 9) How many of the people who received free condoms were male in each of the years of 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.
 - 10)How many of the people who received free condoms were female in each of the years of 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015
 - 11) What other sexual products that were given out freely by the NHS in the years of 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.
 - 12) The youngest age of someone who received free condoms from The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust in the years of 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.
 - 13) The oldest age of someone who received free condoms from The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust in the years of 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.

The Trust does not have a full dataset for 2011 as CASH (Contraception And Sexual Health) did not have an electronic system back then.
