FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST FOI/012757 – Police called to hospital premises

Further to my request regarding security guards earlier this month, I wish to submit a separate request to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 in respect of the following:

1. In 2015, how many times were police called to hospital premises within the Trust?
2. If possible, could you break this down into how many visits by police were related to acts by a) patients b) visitors c) staff d) other (please specify if possible)
3. If possible, for incidents involving acts by patients, please state how many related to patients with dementia.

If it is not possible to provide all the information requested due to the request exceeding the cost of compliance limits identified in Section 12, please only provide the information requested under point 1 and/or 2, or advice me as to how I can break the request down to comply with the time limit.

Police calls 2015 = 70

Of which concerning Patients = 45

Of which concerning Visitors = 15

Of which concerning Crime = 9

Of which concerning Staff = 1

Security is provided by our PFI partner and as per previous response we are unable to break figures down by dementia patients.
