FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST FOI/012996 – Medical students

I would be grateful if you could inform me of the amount of money The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust receives for each medical student being trained at this trust each year and a breakdown of how the money is spent.

The Trust is anticipating receipt of £2.316m in 16/17 for the training of undergraduate medical students. This is based on a tariff of £33,286 per Full Time Equivalent Student although it should be noted that the Trust does not currently receive the full amount as we are moving down a transitional pathway to full tariff.

The funding covers the costs of teaching students (Doctors, AHPs, Nurses) including a simulation unit. This is delivered in an academy style approach. The funding also covers administration and premise costs.
