- 1) How many persons have been admitted to hospitals in your Trust for injuries caused by dog bites or attacks?
- 2) How many persons required inpatient treatment for injuries caused by dog bites or attacks?
- 3) How many persons required surgery for injuries caused by dog bites or attacks?
- 4) How many persons suffered fatal injuries for injuries caused by dog bites or attacks?
- 5) What the total cost of treating injuries caused by dog bites or attacks was to your trust? Please provide information for the following calendar years:
- i) 2013
- ii) 2014
- iii) 2015
- iv) 2016 to date

The response to question 5 has been calculated from the inpatient episodes listed under 1, and then costing the HRG of the episode for these admissions. Patients who had an ICD-10 Diagnosis code of "W54 - Bitten or struck by dog". This can include events such as an elderly patient accidently being knocked over by a dog, rather than just bites or attacks
