COMMENT FROM DIANE WAKE, CHIEF EXECUTIVE, THE DUDLEY GROUP NHS FOUNDATION TRUST

We are pleased that in just four weeks we have already reached 45 per cent of our target to vaccinate 70 per cent of frontline staff against the flu virus by February 2018.

We are confident that we can increase the percentage of staff who have their annual flu jab over the coming weeks to help protect themselves and their patients against the flu virus.

We are required by NHS England to vaccinate 70 per cent of frontline staff against the flu virus by February 2018.

Since the flu vaccines were delivered to the Trust at the start of October, we have set up a programme of drop in clinics supported by 75 staff vaccinators giving the flu jab to staff in their workplace. We also have a high profile social media campaign to encourage as many staff as possible to have the flu jab.

The Board of Directors recognises the importance of this vaccination programme which protects our vulnerable patients from the spread of flu.
