- (2a) Can you tell me what the figure is?
- (2b) Do you have results for individual surgeons?

Do you have data showing the outcome of breast cancer surgery at your trust in relation to:

- (3) Local Recurrence rates for patients five years after mastectomy and breast conserving surgery.
- (3a) Can you tell me what the figures are.
- (3b) Do you have figures for individual surgeons?

The National Cancer Registration and Analysis Service (NCRAS) is run by Public Health England (PHE). It is responsible for cancer registration in England to support cancer epidemiology, public health, service monitoring and research.

The Trust submits information to Public Health England and they would produce risk adjusted figures in the format you are requesting.
