I request the following information:

- 1. Number of RBC units utilised by ward and/ or department in a) 2015 and b) 2016
- Please see table below
- 2. Number of elective surgical procedures cancelled in 2016 due to the patient being identified as anaemic Numbers of cancellations are recorded but the reasons do not drill down to specific illness.
- 3. Number of elective surgical procedures occurring for patients who were anaemic on the day of surgery Information not electronically recorded, this would be in patients notes
- 4. Of the above, the number of these procedures that required a blood transfusion N/A
- 5. Following the NICE Quality Standards published in December 2016 on blood transfusion, is able to meet Quality Standard 1? -

Quality statement 1: Iron supplementation, people with iron-deficiency anaemia who are having surgery are offered iron supplementation before and after surgery.

Response: Yes, screening is offered pre-op, there is a pathway in place for identifying and treating patients who have iron deficiency anaemia pre-operatively. Iron should be offered post-surgery as an alternative to blood transfusion and this area is under consideration for a compliance audit later this year by the Hospital Transfusion Team
