1.a I wish to know what the trust's policy is on cleaning and recycling hospital equipment used by patients, such as wheelchairs and walking sticks?

There is no formal policy however this equipment is cleaned and recycled for patient use.

- 1.b What items, under this policy, which could be cleaned and reused, do you bin after one use? Therapy services cleans and recycles, wheelchairs, walking frames, walking stick, crutches, toilet equipment, chairs, perching stools, kitchen trolleys. only equipment that is identified as single use is thrown away, eg splints, therapeutic putty. For the below questions if there is a way for you to divide the information by equipment type, and quantity, please do.
