The mortuary at Russells Hall Hospital serves the requirements of The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust and also serves as the Public Mortuary for the Borough of Dudley.

The mortuary provides storage facilities for patients who die in hospital and also for those who die in the community when a post mortem is required.

Patients can be stored for longer for example for police forensic cases or social service cases where the Trust sometimes have to use heir hunters to trace families
