FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST 015018 - IT Systems

I am writing to you under the freedom of information act 2000 (The Act) to request the following information from your procurement and contracting department:

- Can you provide details of your current patient record integration/sharing?
 The Trust is currently undertaking the development of patient record integration/sharing solution which is expected to be deployed early 2020
- We are interested in understanding, what your organisation/s uses to share patient information between health and social care clinical systems and settings. Which suppliers are in use in your organisation/s to fulfil this purpose? (If any) examples such as Graphnet, Intersystems, MIG, Direct Integration from/between systems such as Emis, TPP, Cerner?
- The names of systems and suppliers have not been released, Exemption (43) has been applied given it is commercially sensitive in that providing this information may compromise information security. It is imperative that the Trust is cyber resilient, cyber-attacks against infrastructure have the potential to inflict significant, real-life disruption and prevent access to critical services that are vital to the functioning of Trust systems. If release of information could potentially damage the Trust's IT systems this information will not be released.
