

## **Amendments to Visiting on Maternity unit at Russells Hall Hospital from 27<sup>th</sup> July 2020.**

**On the maternity ward your visiting times will depend on the bed that you are in:**

**Visiting times in individual rooms will be 10.00-12.00 and 14.00-16.00.**

**Visiting times in the postnatal bays and transitional care will be as follows:**

**Bed A: Visiting times for birth partner will be 10.00-12.00 and 14.00-16.00**

**Bed B: Visiting times for birth partner will be 12.00-14.00 and 16.00-18.00**

**Bed C: Visiting times for birth partner will be 12.00-14.00 and 16.00-18.00**

**Bed D: Visiting times for birth partner will be 10.00-12.00 and 14.00-16.00**

**During labour one birth partner will be allowed with a labouring woman.**

**During induction of labour it may be possible for partners to visit more frequently. This will need to be discussed with the Lead Midwife**

**If the woman stays on delivery suite following birth visiting will be 10.00-12.00 and 14.00-16.00 for individual rooms for birth partner only.**

## **Midwifery led unit**

**During labour one birth partner will be allowed with a labouring woman.**

**Visiting times following delivery will be 10.00-12.00 and 14.00-16.00.**

**Only** birth partners may attend for visiting time, no grandparent visiting and no children are permitted at this time. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause but this is for the safety of all.

**Please do not attend the maternity unit as a birth partner if you have any symptoms of Covid-19.**
