## Venue

Clinical Education Centre, Russells Hall Hospital with a video link to New Cross Hospital, Wolverhampton Medical staff present based on attendance records (including consultant surgeons, consultant medical oncologists, consultant clinical oncologists, consultant radiologists, consultant histopathologists, junior doctors [Specialist Registrars and Foundation Doctors] clinical nurse specialists and SSMDT coordinator)
