Statement of Purpose

1. OVERVIEW

The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust (RNA) is an acute Trust delivering inpatient and community based regulated activities for a population base of approximately 450,000 from two 'locations', Russell's Hall Hospital and Corbett Hospital Outpatient Centre. Its aim to ensure our patients are the recipients of high quality care pathways and their safety maintained.

The CQC registered The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust on 1st April 2010, without restrictive conditions

3. LOCATIONS

3.1 Russell's Hall Hospital;

This is the inpatient hospital with over 698 beds. It provides the full range of medical and surgical inpatient services, together with an emergency centre, Imaging (MRI and CT scanning), pathology, pharmacy, critical care, maternity, theatres and outpatient clinics.

Supporting this hospital is the:

- **Guest Outpatient Department Centre**

The Guest Outpatient Department Centre is a satellite Centre which offers additional outpatient facilities.

- **Brierley Hill Health and Social Care Centre**

The Brierley Hill Health and Social Care Centre offers office accommodation and additional outpatient facilities

- **Adult Community Services**

The Dudley Group operates a Community Nursing/multidisciplinary service for adults, across the borough of Dudley and Wyre Forrest. These services provide clinical care to patients who are acutely, chronically or terminally ill in their own homes or from GP practices or health centers. The services are multidisciplinary and include both nursing and allied health professionals who interlink with each other through networking pathways. In summary these include;

3.2 Corbett Hospital Outpatient Centre;

This hospital provides day case treatment together with a wide range of outpatient services including: imaging, pharmacy, gynaecology, women’s, physiotherapy, rehabilitation and the wheelchair service. Supporting this hospital is the:

- **Stourbridge Health and Social Care Centre**

The Stourbridge Health and Social Care Centre provides office accommodation and additional outpatient facilities

*** The provision of pathology services changed from 1st October 2018 as part of the NHSI mandated development of Pathology Networks. The Dudley Group NHS FT as one of the four Owner Trusts have agreed to transform the provision of pathology services in the Black Country by restructuring pathology services to generate levels of efficiency savings, by 2020, to the local health economy whilst maintaining high quality standards. This transformation has been effected through the establishment of the Black Country Pathology Service (BCPS) as a hub and spoke model. BCPS is hosted by the Royal Wolverhampton NHS Trust who are also one of the four Owner Trusts on*

behalf of all the Owner Trusts. Laboratory pathology services are currently provided onsite at Russell's Hall Hospital by the BCPS. Immunology and haematology consultants remain employees of DGFT.

4.4 Management of blood and blood derived products

Blood Bank at Russell's Hall Hospital have a service level agreement in place with Mary Steven Hospice for provision of their pre-transfusion testing and provision of any blood components that may be required for their patients.

4.5 Maternity and midwifery services

Our Maternity and Midwifery services are located in Russell's Hall Hospital and consist of antenatal clinic with ultrasound scanning and a day assessment unit. Consultant obstetricians lead the care of women with high risk pregnancies, while community midwives manage the care of the women deemed to be low risk. Intrapartum care for all deliveries is provided by midwives based in the maternity unit. The maternity unit has close links with the paediatric service for the provision of neonatal care and the anaesthetic team for provision of pain relief and management of women with serious pregnancy complications. The service also comprises a full community midwifery service. There is a dedicated team who support new mothers with breastfeeding in hospital and the community.

4.6 Termination of pregnancies

Termination of pregnancies is only performed for foetal abnormality and in life threatening conditions for the mother.

4.7 Services in slimming clinics.

We provide dietary assessment, provision of advice or pharmaceutical intervention to our whole population, to individuals who need to lose weight. This is offered to promote an individuals safety, improve quality of life and/or part of the treatment regime for their medical condition.

4.8 Family Planning services

The Aim of this service is to provide a holistic contraceptive and sexual health service by providing a wide range of free comprehensive contraceptive health care for male and female clients of all ages including diagnosis and choice of treatment.
