Tell us about your role?

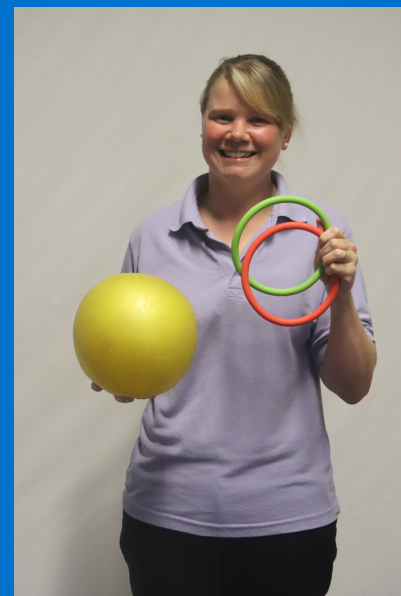
