Tier 3

1. Do you have/ commission a tier 3 weight management service? If so, is this is on behalf of an ICB, (which ICB/ Sub ICB)?

- Yes, as part of Black Country ICB. Initially within Dudley CCG region, but often got referrals from outside of the CCG boundary. Now receiving referrals from across the ICB

2. For how many patients is your tier 3 weight management service (or equivalent specialist weight management service) commissioned for?

- Those who qualify via referral criteria for tier three

3. How many patients have been referred to your tier 3 weight management service (or equivalent specialist weight management service) in the past 12 months?

- Not known, there is no report that can be run for this information as there is no specific tier 3 weight management clinic.

4. How many patients have been treated by your tier 3 weight management service (or equivalent specialist weight management service) in the past 12 months? - Please see response to question 3.

5. What is the average waiting time to access your Tier 3 weight management service (or equivalent specialist weight management service) in the past 12 months? - Depends on clinical urgency triaged clinically for each appointment. Aim is to see within 18 week wait, which most referrals achieve, but at present some are waiting longer than this
