Thank you for requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, please see response below.

1. Does the trust have, or is the trust looking to obtain a HASU (Hyper Acute Stroke Unit) status?

- The Trust has HASU on Ward C8.

2. If yes, what is the trust's HASU status? - Station 2 is HASU which receives direct admission from ED and provides Level 2 care. Thrombolysis occurs on HASU.

3. If not, what is the trust's timeline to gain the HASU status? - N/A

4. How does the Trust manage stroke litigation? - *NHS Resolution manage all clinical negligence claims against the Trust through membership of the Clinical Negligence Scheme for Trusts (CNST) scheme, this includes any claims / litigation relating to stroke.*

5. What were the Trust's costs for managing stroke litigation in the financial year 2022/2023? -

- As a member of NHS Resolution's Clinical Negligence Scheme for Trusts (CNST) scheme, all costs for managing stroke litigation are paid by NHS Resolution.

- 6. How does the trust currently feed into the SSNAP (Sentinel Stroke National Audit Programme)?
- By inputting data into SSNAP sheet (done by Audit Clerk under the supervision of Stroke Co-ordinator)

7. What steps is the trust taking to improve its SSNAP score? - Regularly discussed in our Departmental meetings to identify barriers to improvement and implement changes where appropriate.

8. Does the trust have a 'sophistication index'? E.g. A sophistication index shows the trust's ability to approve and implement projects - Not aware of this index.
