Request Under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Request

- 1. What is the current reported virtual wards beds capacity?
- 2. Out of this capacity, what number/percentage are enabled for remote patient monitoring?
- 3. What is the current utilisation percentage specifically for the virtual ward beds that are enabled for remote patient monitoring (rather the overall utilisation including used for face-to-face consultations)?
- 4. Does the utilisation of the remote patient monitoring-enabled virtual ward beds fluctuate over time? If so, could you provide an average percentage or a breakdown of utilisation across different time periods?
- 5. If you are unable to provide the utilisation percentage(s), could you explain the process used to capture and measure the utilisation of the remote patient monitoring-enabled virtual beds?

Response

Q1: Funded Bed Capacity as follows

Virtual Ward 01 – Respiratory	16
Virtual Ward 03 – Frailty	12
Virtual Ward 04 – Paediatrics	12
Virtual Ward 07 – Heart Failure	6
Virtual Ward 08 – Complex	6
Nutrition	
Virtual Ward 10 – AMU	6

Q3 = 100%

Q4 = Requested breakdown of data is not readily available. We do not hold historical data. Our figures are submitted externally biweekly where we record Occupancy rates against our funded bed capacity levels above. Methodology used to track, is tracking the use of 'Virtual Ward beds' within the period. Where a patients spell between these dates, they were active in the bed slots for 'Virtual Wards'. For example, between a two-week period we may have occupancy of 31

patients which used the 16 available slots on Virtual Ward 01 – Respiratory. This does not mean 31 patients are active at one time, instead usage within the period.

We are required by the national team to submit our occupancy rates as detailed above biweekly for two-week periods at a time. We submit to NHS FDP – NHS Federated Data Platform.
