Thank you for requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Request

Under the FOI Act, please could you supply the following information.

- Since the start of 2021-22, has your trust enacted a model which sets a 'maximum' time for patient handovers between ambulances and your A&E department?
- If so, please describe how the 'maximum handover times' works at your trust
- In which month and year was this first enacted? How often has this model been enacted?
- Is the 'maximum handover time' still in use now? If not, why not?
- Has there been any assessment of the impact of the 'maximum handover time'? If so, please give details.
- If not, do you have plans to enact such a 'maximum handover time' in the next six months?
- If you're not planning to introduce a 'maximum handover time', please could you explain why?

Response

The Trust sets ambulance handover expectations in line with national guidance, and do not set local policies.

We intend to continue with national guidance and therefore will not be setting our own local maximum standards.
