COMMENT FROM PAULA CLARK, CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF THE DUDLEY GROUP NHS FOUNDATION TRUST

Our security teams respond promptly to any requests for assistance when they are required. Our hospital premises, including the Accident and Emergency Department, are also equipped with a CCTV system which is monitored by the Security Department 24 hours a day. Because these cameras are constantly monitored, security staff usually arrive in the department within minutes of an incident occurring.
