I would be grateful to know how many women have had NHS care for ruptured ectopic pregnancies for each month since 1st January 2018 please.

See below for data on ruptured ectopic pregnancies between Jan 2018 - November 2021.

Data has been aggregated into quarters due to low numbers (to avoid identification of individual patients)

ICD10 codes used are below. We do not specifically code ruptured ectopic pregnancies; they are 'included' in all the codes below (see red highlight), so all codes are included

Abdominal pregnancy Excl.: delivery of viable fetus in abdominal pregnancy (O83.3) maternal care for viable fetus in abdominal pregnancy (O36.7)
