	Current Trust staff who are looking to complete their triennial clinical update must complete an IV update refresher course or a clinical update assessment document. They must also complete the Trust IV Drug calculations assessment
	Staff new to Trust with transferable skills in IV Therapy must complete a clinical update assessment document before undertaking the skill.
	Upon completion of the IV training programme, IV calculations tests and competency assessment registered nurses are allowed to administer IV morphine / diamorphine
