FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST FOI/013172 - Sexual health service

We would like to request the following information under the Freedom of Information Act.

Who holds the budget for Long-Acting Reversible Contraceptives (LARC)? Is it you, as a provider of sexual health services, or is it the commissioner of sexual health services?

- 1. If it is yourselves are you able to give me the following information:-
- a. What do you pay GPs for implant and IUD/IUS fittings and removals?
- b. What do you pay GPs for the post fitting check in the case of IUD/IUS?
- c. Do you pay GPs for fitting the IUS for non-contraceptive reasons?
- 2. Do you charge the commissioner for cervical screening carried out in your sexual health service and if so what do you currently charge?

The commissioner holds the budget for LARCs. As a provider of sexual health services, we have a block contract to cover the full range of contraceptive services (including LARCs). The commissioner presumably also procures further services from GPs (the Trust does not sub-contract any work to GPs).

The CASH block contract does not include cervical screening
