Hospital governors celebrate three years of helping make a difference

A trio of community-minded Halesowen residents are celebrating three years of helping to improve health services for the people of the town.

Jane Beard, Rob Johnson and John Balmforth have all served as Governors at The Dudley Group of Hospitals since it became a Foundation Trust in October 2008.

Governors represent the interest of the people in the area they serve and provide a vital link between the Trust and the communities it serves.

As well as gathering the views from local people and feeding that information back to the Trust, they also reflect the interests of the people they represent and work on their behalf to improve health services for the future.
