

# **Contrast bathing**

#### **Patient Information Leaflet**

#### Introduction

After injury or surgery, you may notice some swelling in your hand. Swelling is a normal reaction of the body after an injury or trauma. Much of this is due to a build-up of fluid between the tissues which is called oedema. It may take several days for the swelling to reduce – this is normal.

A treatment called **contrast bathing** can be helpful in reducing swelling in your hand. It does this by alternating warm hand baths with cold hand baths which improves circulation. Reducing the swelling should also make it easier to move your hand.

Contrast bathing should only be carried out when advised by your therapist, when wounds are completely healed and when stitches have been removed.

### What do I have to do?

You will need two clean containers, large enough to fit your whole hand and wrist inside.

- Fill one container with warm water.
- Fill the other with cold water.

#### Step one

- First place your hand in the bowl of warm water.
- Squeeze your hand tightly into a fist and then fully straighten your fingers.
- Repeat this and continue for three minutes.

### Step two

- Next place your hand in the bowl of cold water.
- Squeeze your hand tightly into a fist and then fully straighten your fingers.
- Repeat this and continue for three minutes.

## Repeat steps one and two up to six times.

Always end the session with your hand in the bowl of **cold water**.

It is recommended that you do contrast bathing \_\_\_\_\_ times a day.
