	It was announced in the Budget that Russells Hall Hospital in Dudley would get a portion of a £2.6 billion pot for healthcare. The cash will be spent on the new centre which is currently being built next to the A&E.

We are delighted by the news that we are to receive funding for our new £2.7 million emergency treatment centre which is under construction at Russells Hall Hospital.

The brand new purpose built centre, developed in partnership with Dudley CCG, will house urgent care services. It will be right next to our existing Emergency Department, giving patients an improved single point of access and one stop shop for urgent and emergency treatment.

Having the two services side by side means patients will benefit from a seamless service with clinicians from primary care and the hospital working even more closely together.
