## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST 012879 - Public Health Funerals

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 I seek the following information about the number of funerals your organisation has paid for in the last financial year (1st April 2015-31st March 2016). These are often referred to as public health or pauper funerals.

- How many of these funerals did you arrange in the last financial year?
  One
- 2. How were the funerals providers found on a case-by-case basis or part of a larger contract? The funeral was arranged by our hospital contract funeral directors
- 3. Whose role was it to find the funeral director? with contact details if possible. The trust puts out a tender the contract lasts 3 years.
- 4. Would you list each funeral with the following details for each: the date, whether the body was buried or cremated, whether a funeral service was held, the total cost, and the funeral provider used, whether a local council or another NHS trust contributed any money for this funeral, and if so which.

The funeral was arranged on 30 March 2016.

The body was cremated

There was a service arranged at the crematorium

The cost was £1394.90

The funeral provider was AJ Timmins

The Trust paid the full cost of the funeral

If a person dies in hospital and has relatives who will not, or cannot arrange a funeral for whatever reason, the death is referred to Dudley MBC for a Public Health Funeral.

The Trust only arranges funerals when there are no next of kin
