- The number of incidents reported involving the transfer of surgical patients between hospitals or trusts between March 2015-March 2016 –

8 incidents were reported which involved the transfer of surgical patients to other Trusts or hospitals none of these were classed as 'serious incidents'.

## Please note:-

The Dudley Group have worked hard over the last few years to encourage all our staff to report any incident whether it is a potential incident or a near miss and are pleased that we have a very good reporting culture. This helps us to learn from potential incidents before they have occurred and also any other incidents.

- The number of surgical patients transferred between hospitals or trusts.

The number of surgical patients who have been recorded as admitted between 1<sup>st</sup> March 2015 and 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016 inclusive through inter-hospital transfer is 88. These are patients who have an Admission Source (using the nationally agreed definitions from the NHS Data Dictionary) as follows:

- 49 NHS other <u>Hospital Provider</u> high security psychiatric accommodation in an NHS <u>Hospital Provider</u> (<u>NHS</u>

  <u>Trust</u> or <u>NHS Foundation Trust</u>)
- 51 NHS other <u>Hospital Provider</u> <u>WARD</u> for general <u>PATIENTS</u> or the younger physically disabled or A & E department
- 52 NHS other <u>Hospital Provider</u> <u>WARD</u> for maternity <u>PATIENTS</u> or <u>Neonates</u>
- 53 NHS other <u>Hospital Provider</u> <u>WARD</u> for <u>PATIENTS</u> who are mentally ill or have <u>Learning Disabilities</u>

And under the care of surgical specialties (NHS Data Dictionary Treatment Function Code values '100','101','103','104','105','106','107','110','120','130','140','143','144','160','171','191','214','215','219')

The number of surgical patients who have been recorded as admitted between 1<sup>st</sup> March 2015 and 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016 inclusive and subsequently discharged through inter-hospital transfer is 151.

These are patients who have a Discharge Destination (using the nationally agreed definitions from the NHS Data Dictionary) as follows:
