We are unable to report train travel from the payroll system prior to the implementation of the e-expenses system.

Therefore the only reporting we can provide is from purchase cards for the earlier years. The totals therefore are:

2011-12 - £4,601.43 [Top 5 - £312, £199, £193.66, £193.30 and £174 all were for study or meetings]\*

2012-13 - £3,460.63 [Top 5 - £208, £189.60, 177, £172.18 and £161 all were for study or meetings]\*

2013-14 - £7,139.47 [Top 5 - £273, £272.34, £231, £222.10 and £208 all were for study or meetings]\*

2015-16 - £30,921.60 (includes e-expenses claims) [Top 5 – £380.80, £366, £274, £269 and £236.80 all were for study or meetings]\*
