1a) total number of deaths that have occurred at the Trust in each of the last five years (please provide data broken down by year)

There is no national standard that identifies whether a death is expected or not and therefore this cannot be answered

It is the Trusts normal process to hold an initial round table meeting to determine the scope of the investigation.

There have been 24 investigations into unexpected deaths over the last 5 years. All these were Level 2 comprehensive internal investigation.

There are 6 that remain open and 18 completed and closed
