FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST FOI/013565 – Occupational Health

1.How many headcount (NOT full-time equivalent) nurses (from AfC band 5 and upwards) and doctors (from FY1 and upwards) have sought help from on-site occupational health (OH) services in the past year (April 2016 –April 2017)?

19 Doctors and 7 nursing staff self-referred to our service for the period 1st April 2016 to 31st March 2017
17 Doctors and 193 nursing staff referred by manager for the period 1st April 2016 to 31st March 2017.

2.Of the total number of nurses seeking OH support, what headcount number sought help for anxiety, stress or depression (ASD) or anyother psychological condition?

The Occupational Health team employ 5.6 whole time equivalent staff which provides a service for 4858 staff (headcount). They also provide support to Bank Staff (headcount 1205)
