1. How many patients have been treated for deep vein thrombosis and pulmonary embolism (blood clots) between January 1st 2018 and December 31st 2018? -

Based on first admitting episode and primary diagnosis the Trust had 239 patients treated for DVT and PE

2. How much money has the Trust spent on treating deep vein thrombosis and pulmonary embolism (blood clots) between January 1st 2018 and December 31st 2018? -

Finance Department only have information available for the period April 2018 to December 2018. In this period 186 patients were treated at a cost of £492,000. - We have only included patients whose primary diagnosis was PE or DVT - the patient may have had other conditions which were being treated at the same time.
