In terms of the postage class, only two document types are considered to be sent first class, namely BRST Letter and Clinical Correspondence. The criteria we use is based upon the appointment date and the date of the letter and only if this matches the value configured would the documents be sent first class. In the last 90 days we have sent 80 documents first class, which equates to 0.05%; therefore the remaining 99.95% are sent second class.
