Pain analgesia protocols are in place. For non-elective treatment pathways: Treatment is provided as per in-patient admission and discharge medication supply as stipulated in NHS Standard contract. For elective treatment pathways all patients are counselled and supported to purchase over the counter analgesia and have ready for		

discharge. Analgesia needed as advised by surgical treatment protocol
