Thank you for requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Please provide the following information for Russell's Hall Hospital Emergency Department, operated by The Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust:

1. The number of patients who attended or were admitted via the Emergency Department with diabetes-related complications for each of the last financial year (or the most recent years available).
- We are unable to provide figures for patients who attended the emergency department with the specified complications as the ED attendance reason is a free text field and would rely on the exact phrase to be used in order to pull accurate figures.
2. Where possible, please break this down by:
 - o Diabetic ketoacidosis (DKA)
 - o Severe hypoglycaemia
 - o Hyperglycaemia / HHS
 - o Other diabetes-related complications (if categorised)
