ladies attended the friendly and welcoming workshop which was delivered in Urdu. Attendees were made to feel welcome with light refreshments

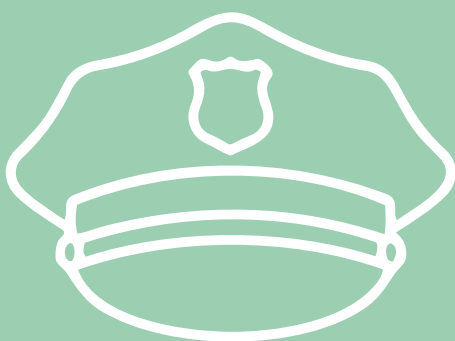
